Tuition & Fee Policy

The mission of Villa Marie is to help students with developmental disabilities discover and live Christ and His Gospel within the context of intellectual, physical, emotional, and social development. To do this, we must recognize the importance of receiving tuition payments. They are truly an investment in your child’s future.

Unsubsidized Cost per Student in the 2026-2027 Fiscal Year:

(If Tuition covered all expenses)

Tuition cost per student approximately \$75,000.

No parents are expected to pay the full amount of cost per student.

Subsidized Tuition Agreement

Most Catholic schools have a fixed tuition rate, based on a percentage of the per pupil cost. Villa Marie is a unique school in that those families who send their children here have few, if any, options for a similar type of education. Therefore, we do not have a set fee for tuition. All families are asked to prayerfully consider how much of the above cost in tuition and board they can pay, and are required to meet with the Director, Msgr. Perkinton, 402-525-6604 **no later than July 17, 2026**. Students whose past year’s financial obligations are delinquent cannot request financial arrangements until their account is current or if an exception is made by the Director in writing.

Tuition Payment Options:

There are four payment options:

- 1. Full Payment (One Payment)** – The entire tuition is due on or before September 5th.
- 2. Semi-Annual (2 Payments)** – Half of the tuition is due on or before September 5th and January 5th.

- 3. Bi-Monthly Payments – (4 payments)** – Bi-monthly payments are due on or before the 5th of the month (September, November, January, March).
- 4. Monthly Payments – (9 payments)** due Sept 5 through May 5).

Late Payments

Should you have difficulty in meeting your tuition obligation, it is your responsibility to notify the principal or director before the 5th of the month, so that special arrangements and adjustments to your agreement can be made in writing. This payment plan must be agreed upon by all parties.

Any graduating student with outstanding tuition or room & board payments that has not made alternative arrangements with the Director in writing, will not be able to participate in end of year activities and graduation ceremonies until all financial obligations have been met.

In the event that there is any outstanding obligation due by a family after July 30th, unless alternative arrangements have been made in writing and approved by the Director of Villa Marie, the student will not be enrolled for the following school year. The student will be allowed to re-enroll after their financial obligations have been met. However, the student's ability to return will be contingent on space availability in the class in which he or she would have otherwise been placed

Late Registrations

Families registering after August 19th shall be expected to fulfill their tuition obligation according to the tuition policy. Tuition for students registering on or after the first day of school shall be prorated over the number of school days they will be attending according to a formula established by the administration.

Refund Policy

For students who withdraw from Villa Marie School, tuition refunds will be issued on an individual basis.
